

Minutes of the Franklin Township Board meeting April 1, 2009

Members of the Franklin Township Board met 4-1-09 at the Wellsville Fire Station as announced. The agenda included normal business items. The meeting was called to order at 7:00. Eldon Radda, Tim O'Dea, Gene Harris and Robert Thomas were present. The minutes from the March 4, 2009 meeting were read and Eldon moved and Gene seconded to approve; minutes approved.

Robert Thomas discussed some of the outstanding purchase requests for the new air bottles and the new emergency lights for the grass rig. These items were tabled until the board could review its financial status and budget limitations. Other outstanding requests include a power washer, chain saw and chains, and 2 new grass masks. These were all tabled for the same reason.

Robert Thomas addressed the way the county handles violations for burning without a burn permit. It was mentioned that it should be taken up with Alan Radcliff.

Robert Thomas discussed charging for responding to calls to people that do not pay taxes within the township. The board will look into the possibility of doing this.

Invoice for all the truck insurances was submitted. Tim O'Dea moved and Eldon seconded to pay the insurance in the amount of \$1730.30. Motion approved.

The board agreed to have the pumper tanker taken to Apparatus Services to be diagnosed.

Next meeting date was set for May 6, 2009 at 7:00.

Eldon moved and Tim seconded to adjourn.
